Susie reported that the office furniture is in and the company will install on Wednesday Sept. 11. The my offering envelopes in the pews are all gone. Deacons will order more envelopes. Gideons contacted John about coming to speak to the congregation, council decided to wait until after the holidays to schedule a date. Rumpke is changing what they charge for trash service at the church. John is going to contact several trash services to check prices. Council decided on the menu for the Over 70 Appreciation Dinner which will be held on Oct. 27, 2024.
